



(June 17th, 2017- By Caleb Slouha) The first annual Military Night had many activities and some great racing from all of the Hy-Vee Racing Series including a 50 lap late model feature with Landon Cassill.

Troy Scott took the lead from Michael Coulborn two laps into the Miller Time Hornets feature. Dallas Chandler slipped to the inside of Scott just one lap later and held off Brad Chandler and Derek Parrott for his first feature win of the year.

For the fourth time this year, Jim Hanson went to victory in the Anderson Automotive Hobby Stocks, but it was not easy. Hanson had to battle through lapped traffic, hold off Kurt Bohnsack, and pass Braxton Franks in the grass to lead just the final lap of the feature.

After struggling the last few weeks, Brady Rhode went back to victory lane in the Dublin City Pub Legends. Mer Slabaugh lead the field to the green but was quickly overtaken by Rhode as he charged through the field on the outside. Cole O'Brien and Todd Ness spun early on in the race, but were able to continue and Rhode won his second feature of the season.

In the Mountain Dew Sportsman, lapped traffic and a fast car helped Cory Houdek win once again. Mike Mitchell led the field to the green, but Greg Hentrich made the pass to the outside before both cars went for a synchronized spin due to fluid on the track. Brandon Herb then led on the restart and was over taken by Houdek shortly after.

The Performance Concepts Late Models had a 50 lap feature with a short half way break. Brian Gibson and Landon Cassill started on the front row with Gibson gaining the advantage. Six laps in, Caleb Adrian took the lead and showed the field the way until Brody Willett made a pass on the outside on the final lap of the first half.

The field was then inverted for the second half, leaving Brad Osborn to lead until Griffin McGrath took the lead two laps in. Osborn was left to battle Caleb Adrian, when the two made contact 5 laps in sending Adrian into the wall. McGrath had a great restart following, but Willett closed in with 10 laps to go, and on the final lap was able to complete the pass to win the \$1000.
