Matt Lacoursiere led the opening laps of the Anderson Automotive Hobby Stocks until Quinn O'Brien and Kurt Bohnsack made it three wide with 15 to go. Bohnsack got the lead, O'Brien took over second place until Jim Hanson grabbed the spot with 11 to go. Hanson began to reel Bohnsack in, but did not have enough time, and Bohnsack won his second race of the season.

Gary Dyer led Mer Slabaugh to the green of the Dublin City Pub Inex Legends. Dyer led the opening laps of the feature, but Austin Slabaugh took the lead with 22 to go. Brady Rhode battled through traffic to take the lead with 14 to go, until he spun due to fluid on the track. Brandon Herb started up front for the Mountain Dew Sportsmen, and got some laps up front until Greg Hentrich spun from second place with 13 laps to go.
