

2018 Late Model Tire Program

Hawkeye Downs will run the Hoosier D800 tire for the Late Model Division

- All tires that will be entered as a “new tire” must be purchased through Hawkeye Downs. Serial numbers will be recorded
- Each car will be allowed to purchase and bank 6 tires to start the season. Tires go to car, not driver.
- After the first night and every night thereafter of competition, each participating car will have earned one new tire for their bank.
- After the first week of competition, the maximum number of new tires allowed on a car is two.
- A new tire is defined as any tire having 5/32 of tread or more.
- A used tire is defined as any tire with 4/32 of tread depth or less
- Any car with more than two new tires or with any new non registered tires during post feature race inspection will be disqualified for the night
- Each driver will be responsible for providing their 4 feature tire serial numbers to the officials prior to the start of the night’s program. Any new tires will be identified by the driver and checked by the official.
- Any car that has competed and earned one tire, but has been absent from the track for more than 3 consecutive races will have the right to purchase a second new tire to get them back into the rotation.

The intent of the program is to provide a competitive, fair, and affordable practice for both the Hawkeye Downs weekly competitors and encourage our teams to travel and compete with us.
